

Cheddar Hash Brown Omelet Recipe photo by Taste of Home

Cheddar Hash Brown Omelet

TOTAL TIME: Prep/Total Time: 20 min.

YIELD: 4 servings.

My husband loves it when I make crescent rolls to go with this easy family favorite. — Betty Kleberger, Florissant, Missouri



Ingredients

2 cups frozen shredded hash brown potatoes, thawed (Fresh works too)

1/2 cup chopped onion

1/2 cup chopped green pepper

2 tablespoons butter

1 cup diced fully cooked ham or Polish sausage

6 large eggs

1/4 cup 2% milk

1/4 teaspoon pepper

1/8 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese



Directions

1. In a 10-in. nonstick skillet, saute potatoes, onion and green pepper in butter until tender. Sprinkle with ham. In a large bowl, whisk eggs, milk, pepper and salt; add to skillet.

2. As eggs set, lift edge, letting uncooked portion flow underneath. When eggs are set, remove from heat. Sprinkle with cheddar cheese; fold omelet in half. Cover; cook for 1-2 minutes or until cheese is melted.

Sweet-and-Spicy Baby Back Ribs



Level: Easy
Total: 1 hr 50 min
Prep: 40 min
Cook: 1 hr 10 min
Yield: 4 to 6 servings

Ingredients:

1/3 cup rice vinegar (not seasoned)

3 1-pound racks baby back pork ribs

Juice of 1 lemon

Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper

1/2 cup lager-style beer

4 tablespoons unsalted butter

8 cloves garlic, thinly sliced (I use 2-4 cloves)

1 tablespoon chipotle chile powder

1 cup Thai sweet chile sauce (such as Mae Ploy)

2 tablespoons packed light brown sugar

1 cup of water

Directions:

1 Preheat the oven to 325 degrees F. Put the ribs meatside down on a cutting board. Insert a paring knife between the membrane and the bones on one end of each rack, then loosen the membrane and pull it off. Rub the ribs with the lemon juice and sprinkle evenly with 1 teaspoon salt and 1/2 teaspoon pepper. Place the ribs bone-side



down in a large roasting pan, then add the beer. Cover tightly with foil, transfer to the oven and roast until the meat pulls away from the bone, about 1 hour.

2 Meanwhile, make the sauce: Melt the butter in a medium saucepan over medium-high heat; add the garlic and cook, stirring occasionally, until slightly golden, about 2 minutes. Add the chile powder and cook 1 minute. Stir in the chile sauce, brown sugar, vinegar and 1 cup water and bring to a boil. Reduce the heat to low and simmer, stirring occasionally, until the sauce is thickened and reduced by half, about 40 minutes. Remove the ribs from the oven; increase the temperature to 400 degrees F. Uncover the pan; carefully pour out the cooking liquid. Stir 1/4 cup cooking liquid into the sauce, then discard the rest of the liquid. Generously brush the ribs with the sauce. Return the pan to the oven and continue roasting, uncovered, until the ribs are golden brown and tender, about 35 minutes. Transfer the ribs to a cutting board and slice, then return to the roasting pan. Pour the remaining sauce on top and toss. Photograph by Anna Williams




