



## 7 Days - 6 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Sept. 8 An early morning departure has you heading to your overnight stop where lodging has been arranged for you this evening (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Sept. 9 Following breakfast, check out and continue traveling towards Maine. Check into your lodging, on the southern coast of Maine, where you will enjoy a delicious dinner. Have a relaxing evening.
- Sept. 10 After breakfast, a guide will meet you to conduct a narrated **sightseeing tour of Portland**, including **Portland Head Light** and **Victoria Mansion** You will view the boyhood home of Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, the restored Old Port Exchange and have a breathtaking view of Casco Bay. In the afternoon you will sit back and relax on a local charter boat for a **narrative cruise on Casco Bay** through Calendar Islands and past Portland Head, Ram Island, Halfway Rock, Spring Point, and Bug Lighthouses. After the cruise, spend some time at the **Perkins Cove** area near your lodging. Tonight enjoy dinner and a relaxing evening enjoying the amenities at the resort.
- Sept. 11 Enjoy a complete breakfast before departing for your ride to the picturesque village of Boothbay Harbor. En route to Boothbay, you will visit Eartha, the revolving and rotating globe. You will also travel through the quaint towns of Brunswick, Bath, and Wiscassett. In Boothbay, you will meet your guide for a tour of the Boothbay area after which you will have free time to browse and shop along the picturesque waterfront which has retained the atmosphere of an old New England village. Boothbay Harbor features brick sidewalks lined with unique shops with handcrafted goods, maritime gifts, antiques and art galleries. Enjoy lunch on your own at one of the waterfront cafes, or just sit back and watch the harbor's activities. Later, you will stop at L.L. Bean and the Factory Outlets for some bargain hunting. You will also visit the Nubble Lighthouse before enjoying a lobsterbake this evening.
- Sept. 12 Following breakfast, check out and depart for a **tour of Kennebunkport**, which includes **Walker's Point**, the Bush Family compound. The property has been a family retreat for more than a century. The estate was first purchased by St. Louis banker, George H. Walker in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century, who built the mansion in 1903. Kennebunkport has been a favorite among artists and writers and features numerous art galleries, craft shops, restored mansions and boutiques. Then, travel to Newport, RI to meet your local guide for a **one-hour tour of Historic Newport**. After the tour, enjoy dinner at the **La Forge Restaurant** on the grounds of the Tennis Hall of Fame followed by checkin at your overnight hotel (pack an overnight bag). Enjoy a restful evening.
- Sept. 13 Breakfast, then check out and depart for the **Breakers Mansion** for a tour of this extravagant home. The Gilded-Age Mansion was built in the 1890s by Cornelius Vanderbilt II; it symbolizes the Vanderbilt Family's social and financial pre-eminence in turn-of-the-century America. After your visit, depart for your overnight stop (pack an ovemight bag) with rest and meal stops on your own.
- Sept. 14 After breakfast, check out and depart for western Pennsylvania to visit the **Flight 93 Memorial** in Stoystown. The Memorial is dedicated to those who lost their lives on September 11, 2001. You will also see the **Tower of Voices**. After your visit, depart for home with meal stops on your own along the way.
